

# The Renewed Life Cycle of a Contract



Building on the success of the Life Cycle of a Contract training day, Shepherd & Wedderburn brings you The Renewed Life Cycle of a Contract training course. Ideal for anybody concerned with contract negotiation and administration, the day continues with the themes of the first training day (but does not rely upon them – and not having attended it will not be an impediment).

The morning sessions cover some contract essentials for those who wish to build or refresh their contract foundation. In the afternoon sessions, delegates will explore some more complex, less clear-cut elements of contracts as well as predictions on contract management. Delegates can choose to attend either or both sessions.

- The series focuses on the contract as an evolving element, considering how its stages influence its overall development.

### Teenage Tantrums (11.00 to 12.00noon)

- One of an interactive series of workshops looking at important stages in a contract's development.
- Using actual examples and case studies, delegates will consider unfair contract terms and the supporting consumer legislation, before tackling the topical topic of exemption clauses, including recent case law.
- The series focuses on the contract as an evolving element, considering how its stages influence its overall development.

### First Love Failings (1.30 to 2.30pm)

- A workshop addressing the key issues and recent cases that developed:
- The duty of good faith in English contract law
- Implied terms and their incorporation in contracts.
- The session will focus on important issues to be borne in mind when drafting or litigating contracts.

### Easy Life (2.45 to 3.45pm)

- A workshop session reviewing key issues in contract management for an organisation including:
- Boilerplate clauses and their relative importance
- Legal risk audits
- Contract automation.
- Delegates will be invited to share their experiences of and predictions for contract administration and management.
